

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Since 01.08.2021, the tightening of the Chemicals Act has been in force.

The Bundestag wants to continue to combat the illegal trade in fluorinated greenhouse gases and, with the current amendment, insists on an extended obligation to provide information and documentation so that, if necessary, the origin and chain of use of the refrigerant can be proven to the supervisory authority.

What does this change mean for us as your retailer?

We are fulfilling our duty as a retailer and will extend our duty to provide information and documentation with immediate effect.

In addition to the previous specifications for the supply of refrigerants such as

- Name and address of the reseller (Robert Schiessl GmbH)
- Date
- Article description
- Container name and size with barcode

We will include the following information (declaration of conformity) on our delivery bills with immediate effect:

- Robert Schiessl GmbH hereby declares that the partially fluorinated hydrocarbons (HFCs/HFCs) sold in the EU are quoted goods in accordance with Regulation (EU) No. 517/2014. For all refrigerants sold by us, corresponding declarations of conformity are available from our suppliers.

What does this change mean for you?

You should be able to present the declaration of conformity listed above in the event of an inspection by the supervisory authority. This documents the route of use of the refrigerant to you; you should also document the further use by the system operator (your customer).
